As a courtesy to you we will file your dental insurance claims. You will need to pay your estimated portion at the time of service.

If you have needed treatment, we are also able to send in a predetermination to your insurance company for you to get an "estimated portion" from your insurance company, however, those state they are not a guarantee.

Ultimately, this is your account and responsibility, regardless of what your insurance company pays or does not pay.

You, as the policy holder need to learn your policy so you can understand your coverage, if you have questions regarding your insurance, please call your insurance company.

Dr. Savoini does not diagnose treatment based on insurance benefits, he will inform you what is needed to best care for your dental health.

Due to the various number of insurance companies and variety of plans available within each of those companies, there is no way for us to know each patients plan, so when we do estimate a "portion" it is a general "guess" based on common percentages that some plans cover. If you go to another dental office for specialty care, that will affect your benefits and we do not know or track your benefits.

We do not send a statement until all claims are closed on the account, so often times if there is more than one person on the account, it may take 1 to 3 months before a statement is generated. When you receive your statement if you have questions, we will be happy to mail an account report. The report will show what services were billed to your insurance and what checks were posted from your insurance.
